



For skippers who would like to figure possible wind effects of surrounding land masses, contours are shown on 5' vertical intervals. The hills are not high and beyond the area of this map run into flat farmland 40' higher than lake level. Slope of most of the south shore is so gradual that it has little effect on wind. The North shore is more abrupt and causes some disturbance. In figuring possible thermal movements on hot days, consider the entire shore wooded, although much of the South shore is low scrub. There is no water current.
