



AVMR2 Update:

Bridging the New and Former Versions of AVMR2

AVMR Course 2 is now a four-day course including more opportunities to discuss place value and multiplication and division instruction. Assessment tasks have also been updated on the multiplication and division assessment making the assessment applicable beyond the basic fact range. The new AVMR 2 Course is based on the book Developing Number Knowledge (the “red book”). This one-day AVMR 2 Update Course is designed to provide participants an opportunity to bridge the gap between the former course and the new course.

****Please note that participants must have completed AVMR Course 2 or KNPI in order to attend this training.**

Participants Will:

- Focus on phases of instruction for multiplication, division, place value, and two-digit addition and subtraction.
- Code and analyze a sample assessment which includes the new tasks.
- Explore exemplary settings and strategies to differentiate instruction.
- Become up-to-date with the most current changes and activities to assure most accurate assessments.
- Have the opportunity to reflect upon previous knowledge and answer questions/concerns regarding current/future practices.
- Apply new skills/activities to assessment settings for future application.
- Acquire knowledge and opportunities to share results of assessments with faculty and parents.
